

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-12

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING A PORTION OF 16TH STREET IN THE CITY OF BRIDGEPORT TO "BAKER BOULEVARD"; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE OF ALL ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Bridgeport is a type A general law municipality located in Wise County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, currently, 16th Street splits into two portions approximately 733 feet south of US Highway 380, and both portions are currently named 16th Street; and

WHEREAS, the western portion of the split of 16th Street, as more particularly shown on the attached Exhibit "A", should be renamed to avoid confusion, particularly with regard to the provision of emergency services; and

WHEREAS, owners of property adjacent to the street being considered for a name change have been notified of the proposed street name change and of the date, time and location of the City Council meeting at which the proposed street name change will be considered; and

WHEREAS, the City Administrator or her designee shall direct the replacement of street signs reflecting the street name change; and

WHEREAS, the Wise County Appraisal District, post office, and other service providers shall be notified at the direction of the City Administrator or her designee of the street name change; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary and in the best interest of the public to rename the portion of 16th Street shown on Exhibit "A" to "Baker Boulevard".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIDGEPORT, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That the portion of 16th Street from US Hwy 380 to 16th Street (Loop 373) as shown on Exhibit "A" is hereby renamed "Baker Boulevard", as shown on the attached and incorporated Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2.

The City Administrator or her designee is hereby directed to erect appropriate signage to reflect the street name change herein approved, and to notify the Wise County Appraisal District, post office, and other service providers of the street name change.

SECTION 3.

This ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances and of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Bridgeport, Texas, as amended, except where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances and such Code, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances and such Code are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining, phrase, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this Ordinance since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without incorporation in this Ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

SECTION 5.

The City Secretary of the City of Bridgeport is hereby directed to publish the caption and effective date clause of this ordinance as authorized by Section 52.011 of the Local Government Code.

SECTION 6.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law, and it is so ordained.


