

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-23

BUDGET AMENDMENT

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2015-2016 OFFICIAL BUDGET, ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2015-15, APPROPRIATING \$3,000 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED FUND BALANCE OF THE HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF BRIDGEPORT MAIN STREET CO-SPONSORING A CONCERT WITH THE BRIDGEPORT CHAMBER, BRIDGEPORT EDC, PARKS AND RECREATION THAT WILL BE HELD INCONJUNCTION WITH THE TASTE OF BRIDGEPORT; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Bridgeport is a home rule city acting under its charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bridgeport previously approved Ordinance number 2015-15, adopting the Official Budget of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend Ordinance Number 2015-15, adopting the Official Budget of the City, by appropriating \$3,000 from the unappropriated balance of the Hotel Occupancy Tax Fund for the purpose of Bridgeport Main Street co-sponsoring a concert with the Bridgeport Chamber, Bridgeport EDC, Bridgeport Parks & Recreation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIDGEPORT, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1

That the Official Budget of the City of Bridgeport, adopted by Ordinance No. 2015-15, is hereby amended by the City Council by appropriating \$3,000 from the unappropriated balance of the Hotel Occupancy Tax Fund for the purpose of Main Street co-sponsoring a concert with the Bridgeport Chamber, Bridgeport EDC, and Bridgeport Parks & Recreation.

The City Secretary is directed to keep and maintain a copy of such Official Budget, as amended, on file in the office of the City Secretary available for inspection by citizens and the general public.

SECTION 2

This ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances of the City of Bridgeport, Texas, except where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of other ordinances, in which even the conflicting provisions of the other ordinances are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance are severable, and if a phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not effect the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of the unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

SECTION 4

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law, and it is so ordained.
