

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-34

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1.200 "PARK PAVILION RENTAL," SECTION 1.500 "NORTHWEST PARK FEES," 1.600 "COMMUNITY CENTER RENTALS," AND 1.1000 "BRIDGEPORT CITY POOL FEES" OF APPENDIX A "FEE SCHEDULE" OF THE BRIDGEPORT CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE OF ALL ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE.

WHEREAS, the City of Bridgeport is a home rule city acting under its charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 08-17 on 18 March 2008 which amended Section 1.200 "Park Pavilion Rates," Ordinance No. 10-33 on 21 September 2010 which amended Section 1.500 "Northwest Park Fees" and Section 1.600 "Community Center Rentals," and Ordinance No. 2011-09 on 22 March 2011 which amended Section 1.1000 "Bridgeport City Pool Fees" of Appendix A "Fee Schedule"; and

WHEREAS, the staff conducted a recreation program cost of service and financial plan study in conjunction with the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 budget process; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the schedule of fees for City services as codified in Appendix A to the Code of Ordinances regarding recreational fees; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that such recreational program fee increases are necessary to fund the operating budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIDGEPORT, TEXAS:

SECTION 1

That Appendix A, "Fee Schedule" of the Bridgeport Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 1.200 Harwood Park Pavilion Rental

- (a) The city council hereby establishes a rental rate of \$50.00 per day for rental of the park pavilion."

“Sec. 1.500 Northwest Park Fees

...

(2) All terrain vehicle (ATV)/bike:

...

(3) Sport utility vehicle (SUV)/utility terrain vehicle (UTV)/Jeep:

...

(6) The city council hereby establishes a rental rate of \$50.00 per day for rental of the Northwest Park Pavilion.

(7) The city council hereby establishes a rental rate to be determined by the City of Bridgeport for rental of the Northwest OHV Park.”

“Sec. 1.600 Community Center Rental

...

(2) Fred Meyers banquet hall:

(A) 8 a.m. – 4 p.m.: \$250.00.

(B) 5 p.m. – Midnight: \$250.00.

(C) 8 a.m. – Midnight: \$350.00.”

“Section 1.1000 Bridgeport City Pool Fees

(a) Daily rates.

(1) Individual, ages 10 years old and up: \$3.00 per person.

(2) Individual, ages 4 to 9 years old: \$2.00 per person.

(3) Individual, ages 3 years old and under: Free.

(4) Groups of 8 or more pre-arranged with the parks department: \$1.00 per person.”

SECTION 2

This ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances and of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Bridgeport, Texas, as amended, except where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances and such Code, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances and such Code are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance are severable, and if a phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not effect the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of the unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

SECTION 4


All rights and remedies of the City of Bridgeport are expressly saved as to any and all violations of the provisions of any ordinances governing sewer rates as of the effective date of this ordinance; and any accrued violations, or pending litigation, both civil and criminal, whether pending in court or not under such ordinances, shall not be affected by this ordinance but may be prosecuted until final disposition by the courts.

SECTION 5

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and it is so ordained. The rates will become effective on November 1, 2016.
